Procedure of the Study

The Descriptive research method was adopted in the present study. It was based on the Survey research method. One Marathi medium teacher education institution in Barshi town was selected. Total 20 B.Ed. student-teachers were selected randomly. Thus, B.Ed. student-teachers from a Marathi medium teacher education institution constituted the sample for the study. The questionnaire was developed by the investigator himself, and was taken for the study. The questionnaire was validated by experts in the concerned field. The questionnaire was given to the B.Ed. student-teachers. There were 20 questions based on gender equality. The questionnaire includes content such as concept of gender equality, nature of gender equality, various barriers of gender equality, sexual harassment, institutional mechanism, women's issue and role of society and education for gender equality. The data obtained through the questionnaire were recorded. Responses of B.Ed. student-teachers to

questionnaire were measures using the key prepared for the purpose. These data were then tabulated and statistical analysis was done for further calculations. The major findings and recommendations are stated with the help of interpretation and analysis of data.

Findings of the Study

The findings of the study were as follows.

- 1) The ninety percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know the concept of gender equality.
- 2) The eighty percentage B.Ed. student-teachers are known about the nature of gender equality.
- 3) The seventy-five percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know the various measures of gender equality.
- 4) The seventy-eight percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know about various barriers of gender equality.
- 5) The seventy--five percentage B.Ed. student-teachers are known about sexual harassment.
- 6) The eighty-two percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know about institutional mechanism.
- 7) The seventy percentage B.Ed. student-teachers try to follow the gender equality in daily life.
- 8) The seventy-two percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know the women's issue.
- 9) The seventy-eight percentage B.Ed. student-teachers know that the role of society and education is important in gender equality.

Recommendations

- 1) The colleges of education should try to conduct orientation course on gender equality for B.Ed. student-teachers.
- 2) The colleges of education should try to introduce the concept and nature of gender equality for B.Ed. student-teachers.
